

## Symptom Management in the Last Days of Life

This session will provide an introduction to the assessment of some of the common symptoms experienced by people at the end of life. This will include:

- Pain
- Nausea and vomiting
- Respiratory secretions
- Terminal agitation

There will be a focus on some of the key drugs prescribed to manage these symptoms. Scenarios will be used to link the theory taught to the reality of everyday clinical practice, including drug conversions.
