

Introduction to Supporting Children who are Bereaved



This study morning, provided in response to demand, can be used as a refresher for the principles of supporting bereaved children or to gain/improve your knowledge base. The focus will be on ensuring that following the death of someone close to them, children will be supported during the bereavement process in discussion with their family/guardian and other professionals. There will be an emphasis on support immediately following the person's death and identification of the child's need for future support.
