#### REGISTRATION DECLARATION

I will be 10 years or over on the day and understand that under 18's are required to be accompanied by a parent/guardian for the duration of the challenge. With a 1:1 ratio of adult to child.

I agree not to attend the ride if I have symptoms of Coronavirus.

I agree not to attend the ride if I have recently tested positive for Coronavirus.

I agree not to attend the ride if I am isolating / anybody in my household or support bubble is isolating.

I agree the information provided is a true and accurate description of my current health and medical state. I understand this event requires a certain minimum level of fitness to undertake the distance.

I acknowledge that as part of Hit the Downs MTB all riders are requested to raise sponsorship for Chestnut Tree House / St Barnabas House.

I agree I will not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs whilst taking part in the ride.

I understand that failure to declare a medical problem may invalidate my health and travel insurance.

I understand that Chestnut Tree House / St Barnabas House may have to cancel my booking if a minimum number of participants do not book onto the event.

I agree that I am riding at my own risk and confirm that the organisers shall not be liable for any accident, injury, loss, or damage as a consequence of my participation.

I agree to wear a bicycle helmet the whole time whilst riding.

I acknowledge that entry fees are non-refundable and non transferable.

I agree to contact Chestnut Tree House / St Barnabas House immediately in the event of any change to the above information.

#### INSURANCE

The cost of a bike has outplacced the increase in the single item limit value on a standard insurance policy. Whereas a standard single item limit might be £250, a bike can be considerably more. Please check with your insurer and ensure you have appropriate cover in place.

I understand that no liability will be accepted for any damage or theft of bikes during the event and that I will arrange suitable insurance.
